Introduction

While later life is a time of contentment and contemplation for many people, aging can also bring about considerable personal loss. This includes the passing of loved ones and a decline in independence and physical abilities, triggering confusing emotions and mental health issues such as anxiety and depression. It can also re awaken earlier losses or mental health problems that are yet to be resolved.

Those who have had lifelong challenges with mental health need ongoing intervention and support in their senior years. It is important to know that these issues are not a natural part of aging and that help is available.

The Seniors Program at Ramsay Clinic Hollywood aims to assist older people manage mental health issues, while moving forward to more content and satisfactory lives.

The program focuses on:

- Adjustment to loss and change
- Managing symptoms of mental health issues, moving toward recovery
- Improving sleep and making healthy lifestyle choices
- Building social connections

Staff

Our team consists of a qualified and experienced mental health nurse, art therapist, social worker, and an occupational therapy assistant.

A psychiatrist oversees patient care.

The Program

The Seniors Program has been designed to meet different patient needs on different days. Groups are small in size and consist of people of similar age and life challenges.

The program draws on a number of evidence-based therapies including Cognitive Behavioural Therapy. Topics include:

- Understanding your mood and managing your symptoms
- Improving communication
- Cognitive stimulation
- Social connection
- Lifestyle education (i.e. nutrition, safety, medications, falls prevention)
- Relaxation
- · Re engaging in meaningful life activities

The progress of each patient is monitored by the team, and staff liaise with other health professionals as needed.

Individual therapy aimed at addressing specific issues can be arranged if needed.

Carer involvement is encouraged. Carers are invited to attend once every month and family/carer meetings are available.

Format

The Seniors Program is a day program that runs from 9.45am to 2.30pm Monday to Friday.

A typical day involves morning exercise, mental health education and therapy with relaxation and topic based activities in the afternoon. Creative expression is also a significant part of the program, allowing clients to explore their thoughts and emotions using art materials. Morning tea and lunch are provided each day.

Eligibility/Referrals

A GP can refer patients to Ramsay Clinic Hollywood Seniors Programme. An appointment is made with the Co-ordinator who will review attendance. If the Seniors Programme is suitable we will arrange for a psychiatrist's assessment to complete the referral process.

Private Health Cover which includes psychiatric care is required for attendance at Ramsay Clinic Hollywood. Should a potential patient have only a lower level of private health insurance that does not allow attendance at this program, it is now possible to upgrade cover to an appropriate level with no waiting period to attend.

Transport
